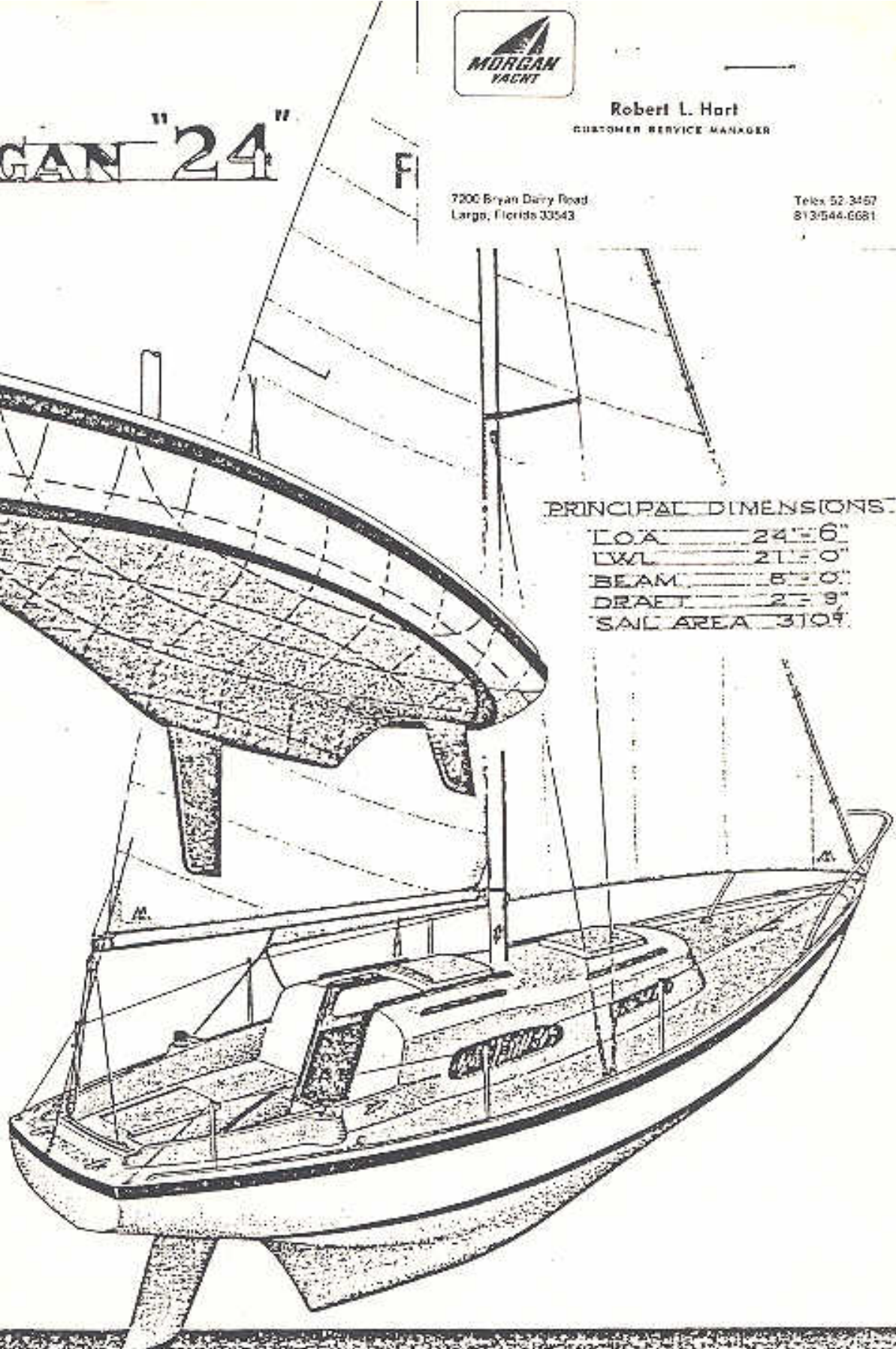

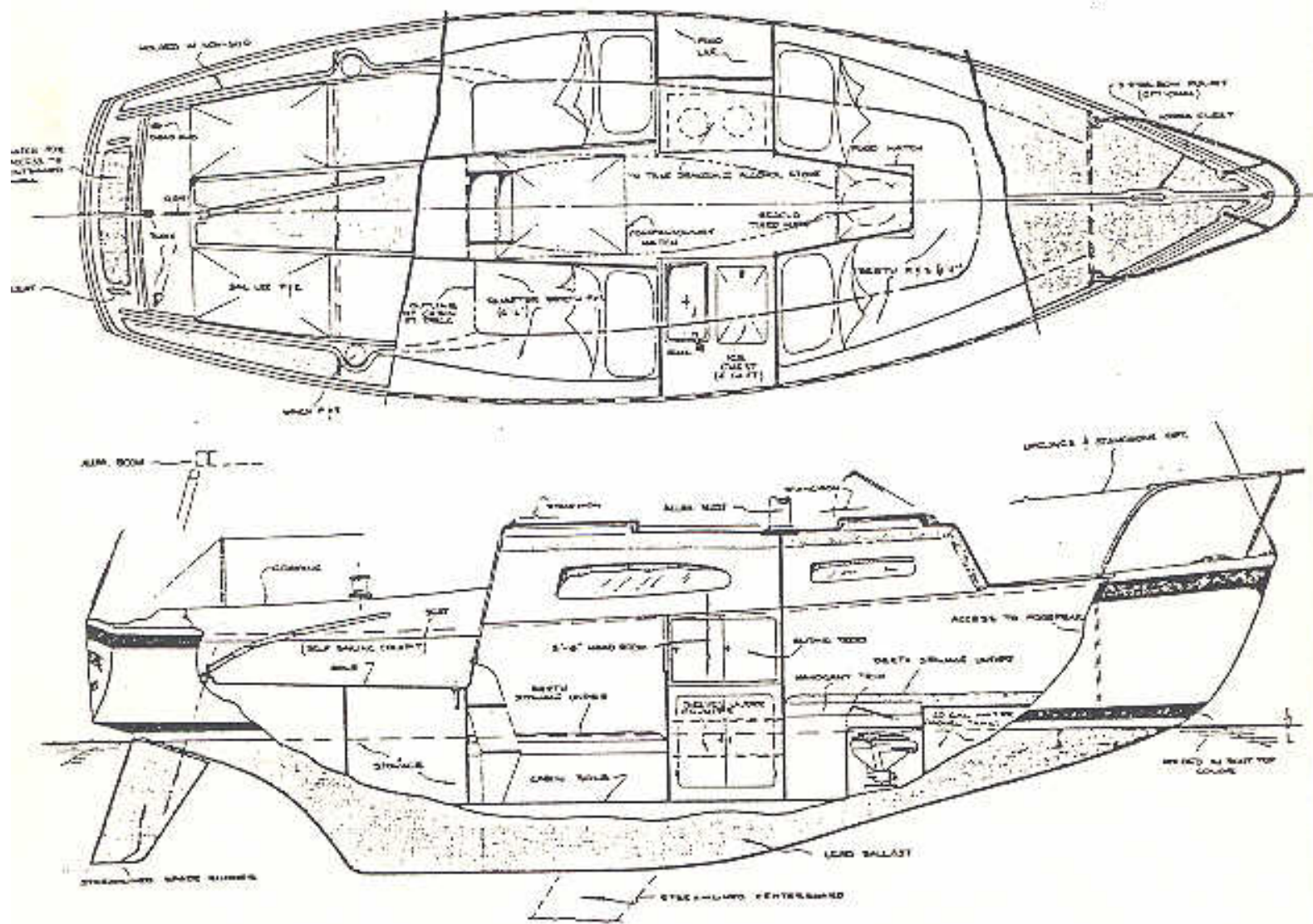

Specifications - Standard Equipment

GENERAL

Modern masthead sloop rig... Designed by Charles Morgan... Trailerable, shoal-draft, keel-centerboard model with centerboard trunk completely below cabin sole... Available as an inboard or for use with standard outboard engine.

HULL & DECK

Molded fiberglass hull with recessed cove stripe and molded in boot top... Molded fiberglass deck with sandwich construction for rigidity and insulation... Anti-skid surfaces molded in deck... Natural finish Burma teak toe rails, companionway boards, slides and exterior hand rails... Flush, recessed thru-hull fittings.

KEEL-CENTERBOARD

Streamlined, fiberglass centerboard... Centerboard winch, stainless steel hoisting pennant, operated from cockpit... Lead ballast, 1900 lbs.

HATCHES

Forward, main companionway and sail locker hatches of molded fiberglass.

PROPULSION

Outboard model has removable panel in transom for convenient mounting of standard outboard engines... Inboard model* is offered with Universal Atomic Four or Palmer M60 (depending upon availability) gasoline engine installation complete with 14 gal. monel fuel tank.

STEERING

Modern streamlined "Spade" rudder... Stainless steel rudder shaft... Special cast tillerhead fitting... laminated tiller, natural finish.

TANKAGE

15 gallon water tank... 14 gallon monelfuel tank* with inboard engine installation.

CABIN INTERIOR

Attractive, easy to care for interior... Bulkheads are paneled in wood-grained Mica, with oiled American walnut trim... Smooth, molded headliner throughout... Carpeted cabin sole... Monomatic head* or chlorinator* available.

GALLEY

A mica-covered counter extending 54" along the starboard side contains an insulated, top-loading ice chest with maple cutting board top... stainless steel sink... 15 gallon tank with hand operated pump... Space for two-burner stove... Stowage for food and utensils is provided behind and under the galley.

ELECTRICAL*

Heavy gauge, 12 volt, 2-wire system with U.S. Government required navigation lights... attractive cabin lights... thermally protected switch panel and heavy duty battery in acid proof box.

MECHANICAL & PIPING

Cockpit located centerboard winch... Recessed flush thru-hull fittings... Bronze valves on all thru-hull fittings below waterline.

COCKPIT

Spacious (8' long) self-draining cockpit... Molded seats, coamings and winch bases... Sail locker hatch to port... Molded anti-skid cockpit sole... Conveniently located controls and instruments on inboard* engine model.

DECK FITTINGS AND HARDWARE

All necessary hardware for working sails... Two, No. 2 top action sheet winches... Jib fairleads... Bow chocks... Bow and stern mooring cleats.

SPARS & RIGGING

Streamlined, aluminum mast, stepped on deck, with tabernacle for ease in lowering mast... Aluminum boom with geared roller reefing, and handle... Sliding gooseneck... No. 1 jib halyard winch... Wire halyards with dacron tails... Dacron main and working jib sheets.
